

COOKIES POLICY

When you connect to the platform, BEEGUP may install various cookies on your terminal. To ensure that the personal data we collect, and process is transparent to you, this cookie policy explains what a cookie is, what types of cookies are used, for what purpose, who the recipients of the data collected are and how you can manage these cookies.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file stored on the hard disk of an Internet user's terminal (computer, tablet, smartphone, games console connected to the Internet, etc.) when a website is consulted, an advertisement is displayed, an email is read, software or a mobile application is installed or used, regardless of the type of terminal used. When you connect to a website or browse a mobile application, a cookie may be sent to your browser by the website or application consulted. Your web browser will store the cookie for a certain period and send it back to the web server each time you reconnect.

Some cookies require consent, others do not ...

Cookies are not subject to consent:

- preserving the choice expressed by users on the deposit of tracers;
- enabling authentication to a service, including those designed to ensure the security of the authentication mechanism, for example by limiting robotic or unexpected access attempts;
- for personalising the user interface (for example, for choosing the language or presentation of a service);
- allowing load balancing of equipment used in a communications service;
- for audience measurement, provided they meet certain conditions.

In general, all cookies whose sole purpose is not to enable or facilitate communication by electronic means or which are not strictly necessary for the provision of an online communication service at the express request of the user require the prior consent of the Internet user.

Our commitment

Rest assured: the simple fact of visiting our platform and browsing or not browsing does not imply acceptance and does not lead to the installation of cookies subject to your prior consent. Refusing to give your consent or failing to make a choice will not prevent you from accessing the platform.

What cookies are used?

Cookies exempt from consent

These cookies are necessary for the platform to function properly and are used to provide the service requested by the user. They cannot be deactivated by default.

These cookies involve the collection of connection data. The legal basis for this processing is BEEGUP's legitimate interest in ensuring the proper functioning of the services offered on the platform.

Matomo, the consent-free audience measurement cookie

The Matomo software - installed on our servers - measures the audience (number of visitors, average length of visits, pages viewed, etc.).

The data collected is immediately anonymised, hosted in France and used solely for audience measurement by our services.

Cookies deposited by Matomo : beginning with `_pk_`, `NSC_` et `MATOMO_` (detail [here](#)).

The data collected by these cookies is kept for a maximum of 25 months and its expiry date is 13 months, as stipulated by the [règlement général sur la protection des données \(RGPD\)](#), and in accordance with the [recommandations de la CNIL](#). the legal basis for this processing is BEEGUP's legitimate interest in improving the services offered on the platform...
